**Mayor's Report**

**Sewer Adjustments- \$1,374.05**

City Manager Foster advised that the new trash truck will be delivered next week. The CDBG grant has been approved for \$630,000.00 toward the sewer rehab projects. We have also been awarded \$950,000.00 with a 5% match for Phase 2 of the Multimodal Access Grant. This will go from 7<sup>th</sup> with a crosswalk, pedestrian lighting, buffers, all the way to the middle school. TDOT has a paving project through that area, so we will work with them. He thanked the staff for their hard work on the Christmas parade and advised that we will be closed Friday and Monday for the holiday.
